THE PROBLEMS:

When the Gold Coast hit one of its worst droughts on record, Dam levels dropped to only 18%. Gold Coast Water introduced high level water restrictions and to prove they were doing their part, installed waterless urinals inside their Evandale Chambers. Unfortunately, the brand they used caused major problems by having to pay for expensive cartridges whenever maintenance was required.

THE SOLUTION:
